Prerequisite- We should have Lookup defined for Service Level and Mode of Transport.

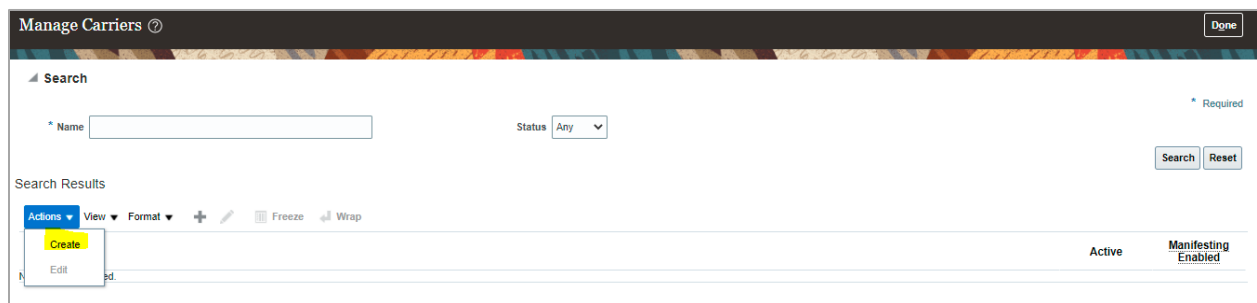

Navigation: Go to-> Setup and Maintenance>>Task>>Search>> Manage Carriers Lookups

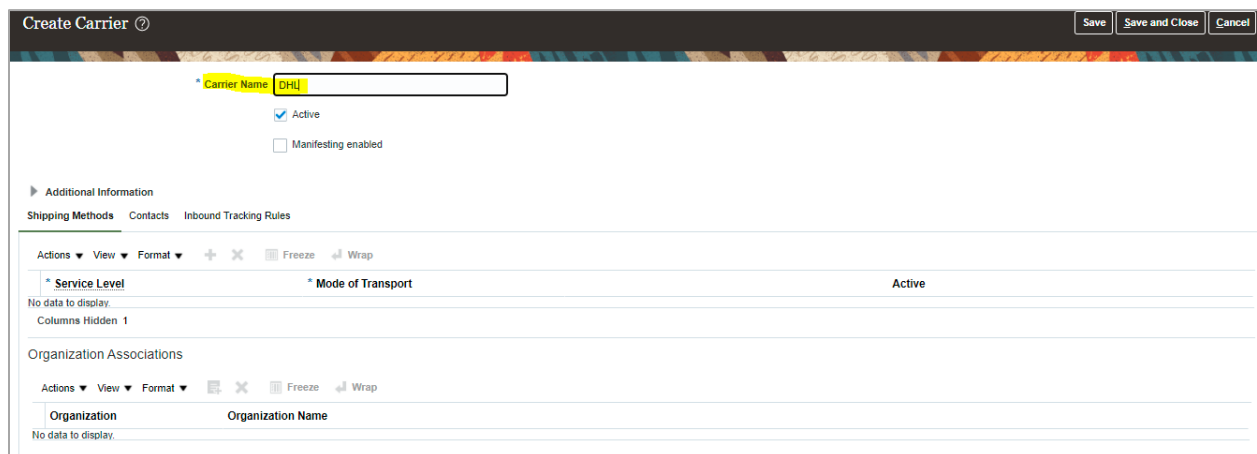
Steps to define Carriers:



To create new carrier click Create under action as highlighted below:

Now Click Add Row and provide the value as highlighted below:


